2018 Nissan Versa Note

Let's say that fuel economy is your primary concern when shopping for your next car. In that case, we really think that a compact vehicle may be the best choice for your needs, and the Nissan Versa Note is one of the most versatile on the market.

Performance

The Nissan Versa Note is all about saving you money on gas. It comes standard with a 1.6L 4-cylinder engine, which features a dual injection system and a Continuously Variable Valve Timing Control System.

Both features work hard to simplify intake and exhaust with your car and to boost overall efficiency. With their help, the Versa Note can easily maintain an EPA-estimated 39 MPG highway and 31 MPG city.¹

Safety Features

While it may be small in size, the Versa Note is big in safety. This car was constructed with the Nissan Zone Body, which is fortified with numerous reinforcements to help it absorb and deflect impact forces.

These reinforcements include:

- Front and rear crumple zones
- Hood buckling creases and safety stops
- Energy-absorbing steering column
- Pipe-style steel side-door guard beam

In addition to this, the Versa Note is lined with the Nissan Advanced Airbag System. This includes front, side, and supplemental airbags, as well as occupant classification sensors to aid in smart airbag deployment.

2018 Nissan Altima

Not all of us like the zippy feel of a compact vehicle. Instead, we'd prefer something with a bit more weight, such as a midsize sedan. If that's what you're looking for, then you might be interested in the Nissan Altima.

Performance

As a midsize car, the Altima can err on the side of both a smaller, more efficient engine, and something far beefier. The standard engine option in the Altima is a 2.5L 4-cylinder engine. This powertrain is capable of producing 179 horsepower and 177 lb-ft of torque.

However, if you're interested in something with more muscle, you may want to spring for the available 3.5L V6. With this engine, your sedan will generate 270 horsepower and 251 lb-ft of torque.

You can also add in available paddle shifters with a manual shift mode. This pairs perfectly with the V6, adding in more of a race-like feel to your car.

Interior Entertainment

As a midsize sedan, the Altima offers quite a few sharp features in the cabin. For example, if cloth seat-trim isn't quite your thing, you can always add in leather and power adjustments to jazz things up a bit.

You'll also have numerous technology upgrades. For example, if you prefer mobile integrative capabilities, you ought to be quite happy with the 7-inch multi-touch control color monitor and its optional apps.

Apple CarPlay[™] and Android Auto[™] are both available to go along with this screen. They allow you to integrate your phone and pull up your favorite apps while on the go.

2018 Nissan Rogue Sport

If you have to switch off between the city and the suburbs often, then you should be happy with a versatile option, such as the Nissan Rogue Sport. This sleek crossover was clearly made for both environments.

Handling

When the roads get rough, you need handling that can navigate them with relative ease. If you add in available Intelligent All-Wheel Drive to your Nissan Rogue Sport, it can do just that.

What makes this AWD system so smart is that it can monitor and read changing road conditions. It will then supply power to your wheels accordingly to ensure the most grip and maneuverability.

In addition to this system, you'll also have Intelligent Trace Control and Engine Braking, as well as Active Ride Control. These can greatly improve cornering and stability.

Interior Space

The Nissan Rogue Sport has 96 cubic feet of passenger space in the cabin. Behind the second row, it has 22.9 cubic feet for cargo.

Of course, what about when you're heading out on a lengthier road trip? In that case, you'll probably have extra gear to transport. To fit it all, you can fold over the back row, expanding the cargo space to 61.6 cubic feet.

The Divide-N-Hide[®] Cargo System then ensures that you're able to secure and stow all your cargo items as needed. Truly, this make those big adventures even easier to manage!

Last but not least, you could always go with a smaller sedan.

The Sentra falls in between the Altima and Versa Note, and it presents drivers with a safe yet still sporty option for day-to-day driving.

Safety Features

If it's added safety features that you're looking for, you'll be happy to know that the Nissan Sentra offers some intuitive gadgets.

Vehicle Dynamic Control and the Traction Control System are both standard in the Sentra. These work to reduce wheelspin and keep your vehicle on course, even when roads are bad.

However, from here, you can upgrade to features that utilize sensors and cameras to monitor the road for you. If they determine that a collision is imminent, they can, in some cases, act autonomously to prevent the event from happening. This available array includes:

- Blind Spot Warning
- Automatic Emergency Braking
- Rear Cross Traffic Alert

Sport Options

What's unique about the Nissan Sentra is that it also offers some distinctly sporty styling and performance features with its NISMO trim.

For one thing, this level adds in a turbocharged powertrain and NISMO aerodynamic body kit. This allows for high speeds and even higher wind resistance.

The NISMO®-tuned suspension and steering increases the maneuverability as well, making it easier to handle when driving fast.

The whole package is completed by the overall sport look of the NISMO 18-inch wheels and signature red-trimmed interior.
